Preparation for British Boarding School Pre-GCSE

There will be four lessons every day from Monday to Saturday, a total of 24 lessons. Each lesson is 45 minutes long.

Main Subjects: eleven lessons a week in Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Business Studies, History and Geography.

Preparation for British Boarding School Pre-A-Level / Pre-IB

The Pre-A-Level online course will run on the same time structure as the Pre-GCSE Course with four lessons every day from Monday to Saturday, a total of 24 lessons. Each lesson is 45 minutes long. Each Pre-A-Level online student will receive an **individual timetable** to include their three chosen subjects.

Main Subjects: eleven lessons a week in **three chosen subjects** from: Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Business Studies and Economics, History and Geography.

Boarding Preparation: four conversation sessions a week run by our Student Hosts
