These courses are suitable for students who will be joining British schools in future, or who are interested in learning more about British education.

Our aims are to give students:

- a good introduction to British boarding school life and education
- chances to listen to many different British voices
- many opportunities to practise speaking English
- a really useful and fun summer course with friendly staff

Timetable:

There will be four lessons every day from Monday to Saturday, a total of 24 lessons. Each lesson is 45 minutes long. Please see our online brochure for sample timetables.

English Language: five lessons a week focusing on speaking and listening skills

Main Subjects: eleven lessons a week in Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Business Studies, History and Geography (Pre-A-Level students will choose three subjects.)

Boarding Preparation: four conversation sessions a week run by our Student Hosts

Saturday Activities: four fun online activities including Drama, Art, Exercise, Meditation, and Virtual Visits to UK cities

Boarding Preparation sessions will cover topics including:

- British education system
- How to be happy and successful in your boarding school
- Life in the boarding house
- The importance of extra-curricular activities
- University Application procedure
- Learning to learn for exams
- Manners and etiquette
- Daily life in the UK

All lessons will be live, with a maximum of 8 students per class.
